The 2022 PSU-Faculty of Medicine International Student Graduate Scholarships
For Ph.D. study

The Department of Epidemiology, Faculty of Medicine, Prince of Songkla University (PSU) realizes that a graduate program is a very important foundation for knowledge creation and high quality research. A graduate program is also a key for international collaboration and academic internationalization. In order to support, strengthen and internationalize the Epidemiology program, the Faculty of Medicine, Prince of Songkla University is proud to announce the Discipline of Excellence in Epidemiology (Phase2) : Asia Mentoring Institute in Research Grant Scholarships for excellent international students to study in the graduate programs at the Faculty of Medicine in 2022.

1. Number of Ph.D. Degree Scholarships:

One scholarship

Programs offered: Epidemiology

2. Duration of Scholarships: 3 Years

3. Eligible Countries: Myanmar, Indonesia, Thailand, China

4. Eligible organizations or institutes of candidates

Due to institute-institute principles of application for the Epidemiology program, the candidates who will apply for this scholarship are required to currently work in the organizations, universities or institutes where they have had previous collaboration with the Epidemiology Unit.

5. Scholarship value:

- 5.1 The monthly allowance (currently 9,000 baht, approx. 300 US\$) covers housing and living expenses for 24 months when the candidate is living in Thailand)
- 5.2 Tuition fee
- 5.3 Research budget (not more than 100,000 baht)

6. Application Requirements:

- 6.1 International students with good academic record and research experience
- 6.2 Eligibility is restricted to new graduate students who are expecting to begin their studies at Prince of Songkla University in semester 1/2022 (June 2022).
- 6.3 The applicant must hold a Master's degree. The subject in which the previous degree was obtained must match and fulfill the requirements of the program's curriculum (see details of the program).
- 6.4 The applicant must not be a recipient of another scholarship that covers living expenses during the same period.
- 6.5 The applicant must pass an officially recognized English language examination as follows:

- TOEFL Paper-based score of 500, or higher
computer-based score of 213, or higher
internet-based score of 79, or higher
 - IELTS Score of 5.0 or higher
- 6.6 The applicant can choose only one program to apply for.

7. Terms and Conditions:

- 7.1 The applicant must be a full time student with non-immigrant "ED" visa (Study Permit). The applicant entering Thailand on a tourist visa cannot enroll and may have his/her scholarship cancelled.
- 7.2 The student must study and perform the research thesis
- 7.3 The student must report the progress of his/her study to the department of Epidemiology, every 6 months.
- 7.4 The student must pass the proposal examination within the third semester.
- 7.5 To fulfill the scholarship requirements, the scholar must publish two articles from his/her dissertation in reputable, peer-reviewed international journal(s) of which at least one is indexed in the Web of Science (ISI impact factor).
- 7.6 Once an applicant has been accepted for a particular program of study, they are expected to complete that program, complete the study within the given time frame and cannot change to a different program of study.
- 7.7 If the student has no progress on his/her study or thesis without a valid reason, the committee of each graduate program has to inform the Epidemiology Unit to terminate the scholarship.
- 7.8 Other terms may apply as established by the Faculty of Medicine.

8. Required Documents:

- 8.1 A copy of an English proficiency certificate (valid within 2 years) with a minimum score as specified in section 6.5
- 8.2 Curriculum Vitae
- 8.3 A certified copy of transcript of records for bachelor's/master's degree study with grades and grade point average specified in English
- 8.4 Statement of purpose (approximately 500-800 words)
- 8.5 First page of all published articles
- 8.6 Research description/plan
- 8.7 A copy of the photo page
- 8.8 A medical certificate (in English)
- 8.9 Recommendation from the applicant's last workplace
- 8.10 Endorsed letter from Institutes collaborative with the Epidemiology Unit

Remark: The Epidemiology program of the Faculty of Medicine reserves the right to reject an application if the required documents are not complete.

7. How to apply:

Applications must be submitted online at <https://grad.psu.ac.th/en/prospective-students/admission.html>. The required documents (9 items) must be uploaded via the PSU Graduate School website for the committee to review. The applicant must choose **"Others"** for **Source of Funding** and fill **"Apply for the Discipline of Excellence in Epidemiology (Phase2) : Asia Mentoring Institute in Research Grant Scholarship (DOE scholarship)"**.
