**1) Position-Specific Qualifications**

- 1.1 Doctoral degree in health-related fields
- 1.2 Knowledge of epidemiology and statistical analyses
- 1.3 Experience in applying for grants or conducting clinical / public health / community health research
- 1.4 TOEFL (PBT) score of at least 550 points, or TOEFL (iBT) of at least 79 points, or IELTS overall band score of 6.0 points
- 1.5 Special consideration for those with experience in teaching or research
