## English Language Proficiency Requirement in Graduate Study, PSU

1) The English Language Proficiency requirement for the MSc and PhD degrees (International Programme) are as follows:

TOEFL (Paper Based)	≥ 500	
TOEFL (Institutional Testing Program) ≥ 520		≥ 520

TOEFL (Internet Based)	≥ 61	
CU-TEP	≥ 60	
IELTS	≥ 5.0	
PSU-TEP	≥ 60% average score of reading & structure,

\*The date of the examination should not be more than 2 years before the enrollment date for the MSc and PhD degree programme.

## Procedure:

- 1.1) Submit English Language Proficiency Test Score to the educational support staff (Ms. Erma-amariya).
- 1.2) Ms. Erma-amariya will report the English score to the Graduate School.

\*\*\* MSc students have to submit the English score by semester 1 of the 2<sup>nd</sup> year. \*\*\* PhD students have to submit the English score by semester 1 of the 3<sup>rd</sup> year.

- 2) In case students have not passed 60% in PSU-TEP or CU-TEP, students can register to the English course code **890-902 Academic English for Doctoral Students 4(4-0-8)** in semester 1. The English course is usually held on Saturday and Sunday for around 6 weeks in October and November. The registration fee of this course is 6,000 baht. The procedure is as follows:
  - 2.1) After students have passed the English course (got "S"), they should submit the best score of PSU-TEP or CU-TEP to the educational support staff (Ms.Irma-Amariya).
  - 2.2) Ms. Irma-Amariya will submit the general request form (form no. 1) to the Graduate School.
  - 2.3) The Graduate School will consider the average score of PSU-TEP or CU-TEP together with the score of the English course code 890-902 and announce the result afterwards.

Marks: Students who have never tested PSU-TEP or CU-TEP cannot register the English course code 890-902.

- 3) In the last year of study (5<sup>th</sup> year for MSc degree students or 8<sup>th</sup> year for PhD degree students), in case students have passed the Thesis Examination but have not passed the English Proficiency test yet, the Graduate School offers the *Special English Proficiency Test* which composes 100 score as following details:
  - **60 score:** Online English Proficiency test including reading & structure, listening and writing skill. Each skill is worth 20 score.
  - **20 score:** Study Tell Me More programme at least 240 hours in 1 semester.
  - 20 score: Interview for testing speaking skills.
- 4) The passing scale is at least 60 score out of 100.
- 5) Test fee: 100 baht/time.
- 6) Test schedule: in the middle of May and December.

## Procedure:

- 6.1) Submit all necessary documents including the best score of PSU-TEP or CU-TEP and Tell Me More Programme result to the educational support staff (Ms.Irma-Amariya) **before May/December.**
- 6.2) Ms. Irma-Amariya will submit the general request form (form no. 1) to the Graduate School to request the Special English Proficiency Test.
- 6.3) Sit in the Online English Online Proficiency Test and the Interview conducted by the Graduate School, PSU in Middle of May/December.
- 6.4) The Graduate School will consider and announce the result afterwards.

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
